Assistant Special Inspections Technician

Duties and Responsibilities/Specific Tasks:

- Entry-level technician/inspector who provides site inspection along with field and laboratory testing under the direct supervision of associate/senior level technicians and/ or project managers.
- Daily field and/or laboratory report preparation and file management for multiple projects.
- Must traverse and work in all types of terrain, all kinds of weather conditions and projects in various stages of construction.

Minimum Education and Certification Requirements:

- Some experience in construction and general computer use.
- Associates Degree from a technical or four-year school preferred.
- ACI Grade I and Nuclear Gauge preferred but not required.
- May be enrolled in a college engineering program.

Minimum Expectations:

- General computer skills.
- Ability to ask questions and follow supervisor's instructions.
- Possess excellent verbal and written communication skills.
- Interpersonal, problem-solving and decision making skills.
- Work requires willingness to work a flexible schedule with some travel, and the ability to work long hours while maintaining concentration.
- Ability to frequently lift up to 90 pounds and consistently lift up to 40 pounds repeatedly
- Valid driver's license and good driving record.
